Below is a list of common issues to keep watch for:

- Grass is not to exceed 8". Grass clippings, etc. to be kept out of right-of-way.
- Garbage is required to be in an enclosed (lidded) garbage container or bag.
- Appliances, clothes, tires, vehicle parts, etc. should be stored in enclosed structures.
- Vehicles are required to be parked on a hard compact surface or stored in an enclosed accessory structure.
