


# 2025 Chapple Avenue Reconstruction Project



# Project Area + Impact

- 6<sup>th</sup> St W to 11<sup>th</sup> St W
- 1800 feet of reconstructed road (5 blocks)
- 1780 feet of new water main
  - Replacing pipe from 1889
- 20 lead service lines to be replaced
- New storm sewer
  - Improving capacity
- Sharrows (markings for shared bike path)



# Schedule + Safety

- City crew - road removals: **Wednesday, April 23<sup>rd</sup>**
- Jake's Excavating crew - mobilizing and pipe removals: **Monday, April 28<sup>th</sup>**
- Crews will start work after 7:00am and finish prior to 8:00pm most days
  - Noise ordinance: 7:00am - 10:00pm (Ashland Code 202.04)
- Road will be opened up no later than October 15<sup>th</sup>
- 2nd layer of asphalt: Spring/Summer 2026


## When road is closed:

- Driving on road is not allowed
- No street parking
- Pedestrians must keep off road



# Trees

- 22 trees (out of 65) were removed due to water line conflict and poor health conditions
  - Dead and/or impacted by Emerald Ash Borer
  - Local arborist assessed all Chapple trees
- Replanting in Fall 2026



## Water

- Pitcher filters for lead service line replacements
- Temporary water
- 72-hr notice before water shut-off


## Mail

- Have attempted to contact Post Office to coordinate temporary mail (ongoing)
- Residents with concerns should contact the Post Office directly

## Garbage

- Garbage service will not be affected
- If you do not have alley access, contact Utility Department
